1. 대화를 듣고, 여자의 마지막 말에 대한 남자의 응답으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Hi, is it possible to see Dr. Harris today or tomorrow?  
M: I'm afraid not. Both days are fully booked.  
W: Then, when will he be available?

2. 대화를 듣고, 남자의 마지막 말에 대한 여자의 응답으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Rachel, did you make plans for winter vacation?  
W: Well, I'd like to go on a trip abroad this time, but I haven't decided where to go yet.  
M: Why don't you ask Christine for advice? She has traveled overseas a lot.

3. 다음을 듣고, 여자가 하는 말의 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Hello, everyone. I'm Ms. Parker, the school librarian. As you know, September is the school's reading month. So, we're offering a variety of interesting book-related events. Today, I'd like to introduce an event you'll be interested in. It's a book cover design exhibition. The book covers are not designed by professional designers but by the school's book club members. Each member chose one of their favorite books and redesigned its cover to express their feelings and thoughts about the book. The book covers are now on display in the library. Please feel free to drop by and take a look at the creatively redesigned book covers. Thank you.

4. 대화를 듣고, 남자의 의견으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Hi, Monica. I haven't seen you at the gym in a while.  
W: Yes. I've been out of town on business.  
M: Glad to see you again. I saw you running very quickly on the treadmill.  
W: Right. These days I'm gaining weight. So, I decided to work out more intensely.  
M: Hmm.... That's not a good idea this late at night.  
W: Well, I heard that running fast helps burn calories.  
M: That's right. But intense evening exercise is not good for sleep.  
W: Oh, it's not? I thought exercising before bedtime could make me exhausted and help me sleep.  
M: I'm afraid you're mistaken. Heavy exercise in the evening raises your heart rate and body temperature, so it prevents you from falling into a deep sleep.  
W: I see. Now I know why people say, "Evening walk, morning run."

5. 대화를 듣고, 두 사람의 관계를 가장 잘 나타낸 것을 고르시오.

W: Hi, Mr. Jake Cooper. Welcome!  
M: Thanks for having me here. Actually, I'm a big fan of yours. I listen to your show every day.  
W: Oh, I'm flattered. So, you became famous as the creator of the "Peacock Dance." I really love that dance, and so does everyone else.

W: Sounds interesting. I heard you're now developing dance moves for the dance team called Wild Things. Is that right?  
M: Yes, I'm working on a new style of dance with them.  
W: Awesome! Now our radio listeners have started sending in questions for you. We'll answer those after the break.

W: Thanks. What do you think about these two balloons in the top right corner?  
M: Hmm.... Didn't we decide to put three?  
W: We did, but there wasn't enough room for three balloons.  
M: Okay. You put the date and location in a star. The star makes it stand out.  
W: Right. Is there anything I should change?  
M: No, it looks great.

M: Reina, what are you reading?

W: Hi, Peter. This is a book that introduces simple yoga poses.

M: I didn't know you're interested in yoga.

W: I became interested in it recently since I heard yoga could help to relieve my back pain.

M: Well, why don't you go to see a doctor first?

W: Actually I did, and the doctor recommended yoga for me.

M: I see. Then how about taking a yoga class at the community center?

W: When I checked, the class hours didn't fit my schedule. So, I'm looking for some simple yoga poses I can do every day from this book.

M: Then I'll send you some yoga video clips through email. You can follow the poses while watching them.

W: Oh, that would be great. Thanks a lot.

8. 대화를 듣고, 여자가 구입한 신발을 환불받을 수 없는 이유를 고르시오.

M: Hello, how may I help you?

M: Okay. When did you buy them?

W: Last Saturday. Can I get a refund?

M: Okay, did you bring the receipt?

W: Sure, here it is.

In this situation, what would Helen most likely say to Tom?

First, Greek yogurt is filled with calcium. Add some honey to give it some sweetness, and it'll keep you feeling full throughout the morning.
