1. 다음을 듣고, 여자가 하는 말의 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Hello, this is Karen Smith, the principal of Sunnyfield High School. I would like to inform all staff about an important plan for next week's Parent-Teacher Meeting. Due to limited parking on campus, all teachers and staff should park at the nearby community center on Wednesday. It is only a five-minute walk from the school. This plan will ensure that parents attending the meeting have easy access to parking. Your cooperation will greatly assist in making this event a smooth and successful experience. Thank you in advance for your cooperation with the parking arrangements.
