1. 다음을 듣고, 여자가 하는 말의 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Good afternoon, students. This is your principal, Ms. Johnson. I'd like to announce that there has been a change of schedule for our weekly walking program, *Step Together*. It was originally supposed to take place every Monday after school, starting next week. However, it seems that many students are busy with club activities after school. Therefore, in order to allow more students to participate, it'll now be held at 1 p.m. during lunchtime. We hope this change gives you the opportunity to enjoy meaningful moments with your friends. We look forward to seeing you there!

2. 대화를 듣고, 남자의 의견으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Honey, how about having beef for dinner tonight? We have some in the freezer.
M: Great idea, but that beef has been in the freezer for so long. We'd better not eat it.
W: Well, it's been frozen this whole time, so it should be fine.
M: Not really. Eating food that's been kept frozen for a long time can be harmful.
W: Really? I thought it would be alright.
M: Well, while freezing can slow bacteria growth in food, it cannot completely stop them from growing.
W: Hmm, that makes sense.
M: Besides, if we open the freezer often, the temperature inside doesn't stay constant.
W: Oh. That might also encourage bacteria growth.
M: Correct! That's why it can be harmful to eat food that's been stored frozen for a long time.
W: I see. Let's go grocery shopping for some beef then.

This can prevent you from recognizing and reacting to dangerous situations. For example, you may not notice when cars are coming towards you or when bicycles are passing by. For your own safety, please think twice about using wireless earphones when you're walking. I'll be back with some more useful advice next time.

W: Hello, students. As you know, animals build many different structures in the natural world. Today, we'll talk about the different functions that these structures have. First, an important function of animal-built structures is to provide protection from predators. For example, beavers build dams to create ponds where they can construct their homes. These structures provide a shelter from predators. Next, animal structures can also play a role in transportation. Some species of ants use their own bodies to create bridges. These bridges provide a path over obstacles and allow them to search for food at an increased speed. In addition, animal structures can serve as traps. This can be observed in web-building spiders, who weave elaborate webs of sticky spider silk that capture prey. Finally, animal structures can serve as a means of attracting mates. During mating season, some species of birds collect small branches, leaves, and colorful objects to create structures that attract the attention of females. Now, let's watch a short video about these incredible animal structures.
