1. 다음을 듣고, 여자가 하는 말의 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Good afternoon, students of Robinson High School. This is your principal. I have an important announcement for all of you. Due to major construction, we are planning to close the school cafeteria. M: Good morning, students. Last week, we briefly learned about the effect of colors on people's mood. Today, we're going to look at the ways they influence athletes' performance in sports. First, red can raise an athlete's energy and push them to act more boldly during play. It often increases physical effort, which may help in fast or aggressive sports. Second, to help athletes stay calm under pressure in close games, blue is useful. It also supports clear thinking, which can lead to better choices in games. Third, green gives a sense of balance and encourages a steady pace. This color can reduce stress as well, which helps athletes stay relaxed during long events. Finally, power and strong presence are linked to black. It may help athletes feel more confident when they compete. Now, let's see some examples from around the world showing how sports teams use them to benefit their athletes.
