ANN: 이제 시작하겠습니다.

**1번 대화를 듣고, 두 사람이 주문할 옷을 고르시오.**

M: Why don't we get club sweatshirts? We can wear them when we do volunteer work.

W: That sounds great! But I think a sweatshirt with a hood would be better. The hood can be useful on cold days.

M: Good! I like that. Do you have any ideas about a design?

W: How about a striped pattern? That would look good.
