ANN: 이제 시작하겠습니다.

1번 대화를 듣고, 두 사람이 주문할 가방을 고르시오.

W: Honey, look at this screen. Which bag should we order for Jessie's birthday, a shoulder bag or a backpack?

M: Hmm..., a backpack would be more convenient for her.

W: I agree. Then, let's choose one from the animal-shaped backpacks.

M: Good. How about these three kinds of shapes: an elephant, a bear or a rabbit?

W: They're all good. But the rabbit-shaped one would be best. She likes rabbits.

M: Yeah, you're right. It's also cute.

W: Perfect. Let's order it now.

M: Okay.
