ANN: 이제 시작하겠습니다.

**1번 대화를 듣고, 여자가 구입할 수영모를 고르시오.**

M: Hello. How can I help you?

W: I'm looking for a swimming cap.

M: We have ready-made ones or you can design your own.

W: I'd like to make my own swimming cap.

M: Sure. First, choose a pattern. The dotted pattern is the most popular.

W: Actually, I don't want a pattern.

M: Okay. Next, you can add your favorite image.

W: Please add a palm tree to it.

M: Alright. Lastly, would you like to include your name on it?

W: Yes. Please write the name 'AMY' next to the tree. I'll pay by credit card.

M: Thank you for your purchase.

M: No, it's not that bad. But, it still hurts.

W: I hope to see you at the gym after you get better.

5번 대화를 듣고, 여자가 남자에게 전화한 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Hi, Molly. What's up?

W: Hi, Andrew. Are you going to the chess club?

M: Yes, I'm on my way.

W: Oh, that's good. I have something to ask you.

W: It's about my younger sister, Lisa. She went to the chess club.

M: I know her. We're both in the same club.

W: If you see her, will you tell her to quickly come home? I called her several times, but she's not answering.

M: Sure, I will. What's wrong?

W: We're just visiting our grandpa earlier than planned. So, she needs to come home soon.

M: Alright. When I get there, I'll let her know.
