ANN: 이제 시작하겠습니다.

1번 대화를 듣고, 두 사람이 주문할 수영복을 고르시오.

W: Honey, we should buy Stephanie's new swimsuit for the summer vacation.

M: You're right. Let's order it online. *[Pause]* What should we consider first?

W: Hmm... What about style? Which one is better, a one-piece or a two-piece swimsuit?

M: Let's go with a two-piece. She already has a one-piece swimsuit.
