1번 대화를 듣고, 여자가 구입할 유리병을 고르시오.

M: Welcome to Best Kitchen Tools. How can I help you?

W: Hi. I'd like to buy a new jar.

M: Sure! We have two shapes, round and square. Which do you prefer?

W: I think a round jar looks nicer. I'll choose that shape.
